

Euro Declaration - How to

When goods are imported to Iceland from an EES country and the invoice is specifically treated by the sender (seller) then the buyer in Iceland does not have to pay any Customs Taxes.

This is how the invoice must look like in order to have Customs accept the paper:

- The sender (seller) needs to present an invoice which has a specific text (see examples below) written on the invoice using a language which suits the seller. This text may not be a cut out paper glued on top of the invoice but rather a handwritten text or printed with a printer.
- The invoice needs to be stamped with the sellers company logo
- The following must also be written on the invoice with a pen:
 - a. Name of the person who signs the invoice (in letters)
 - b. The signature of the person who signs the invoice (their name)
 - c. The current date
 - d. The sellers country

Below you can see the standard text in various languages and one of them needs to be on the invoice.
